Santé Center for Healing, a 54-bed inpatient facility, is situated on a hilltop on 14 acres of rolling hills in Argyle, Texas, approximately 30 miles north of Dallas/Fort Worth. Santé Center offers treatment and rehabilitation for those suffering from drug abuse and addiction, eating disorders, and complex behavioral health issues. Individuals who have lost hope because of addiction can find treatment and recovery at Santé. Patients at Santé receive a spectrum of addiction treatment addressing the whole person—mind, body, and emotions. Whether residential or outpatient rehabilitation, the Santé staff are dedicated to the creation of a clinical treatment atmosphere needed to work with all substance abuse and other compulsion or addiction issues, including but not limited to sexual issues and eating disordered behavior.



The Mission of Santé Center for Healing is to address addictive behaviors and associated conditions with an integrated addiction treatment model, drawing from traditional and innovative approaches. Our services are open to individuals and families who seek recovery from addictive behaviors, with a focus on treating the addicted professional. We provide treatment with integrity, promoting wellness for the patient and their family in a safe, pleasant, and tranquil recovery setting.

Santé Center provides an interdisciplinary approach to treatment, including medical, psychiatry, psychology, and counseling. Patients' treatment plans are individualized, and may include individual psychotherapy, group therapy, and couples/family therapy.

The Practicum Training Program

Overview

The practicum training program is generally a two-semester, structured training program that commences the beginning of each fall, spring, and summer semester. Practicum students are expected to work a minimum of 20 hours per week, spending at least half their hours per week having face to face contact with patients. The remaining hours in practicum-related activities include clinical paperwork, report writing, supervision, and didactic seminars.

Practicum Experience

At Santé, practicum students will provide individual, group, and experiential therapy working with a variety of patients with both substances and process addictions. Family interventions and administration of psychological assessment may also be part of a practicum student's training experience.

Supervision and Didactics

The practicum training program will provide one hour of individual supervision per week with an assigned case manager and one hour of group supervision facilitated by pre-doctoral interns. Practicum students will also participate in daily treatment team meetings and weekly didactic seminars.

Practicum Student Resources & Benefits

Practicum students at Santé will be provided with a group office that is equipped with a telephone, printer, a personal computer with Internet access, email, Microsoft Office Software, and general office supplies needed to complete assigned duties. Practicum students are also provided with a complimentary lunch each day.

Applying for a Practicum Position at Santé Center for Healing



Eligibility for Application

Practicum students are offered positions at Santé each semester. To be considered for a practicum position, applicants must be enrolled at a masters or doctoral program in a counseling or related field.

Applicants must submit a resume and a letter of interest to the Director of Training. Applicants who meet the minimum requirements specified above are offered an on-site interview with the Director of Training.

Criteria for Consideration

To be offered a practicum position, students agree to a two-semester commitment. They are required to be on-site Wednesday mornings to participate in mandatory training activities and must be present for two of the three case management groups, which occur on Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday afternoons.
