Santé's Licensed Professional Assessment (LPA) program offers a fair, precise and objective investigation of the professional in crisis. Data collected during the assessment is then used to gauge the professional's ability to return to work, provide monitoring recommendations and/or the necessity for the professional to seek further addiction treatment or other intervention. This information is provided in a formal written report to the referral partner within a timeframe agreed upon with the respective organization.

ASSESSMENT OVERVIEW

- Biopsychosocial assessment
- Family systems assessment
- Onsite psychological testing
- History and examination by psychologist with psychological screening
- Additional testing, if necessary, including polygraphs
- Preliminary results are given the day after discharge
- Drug testing with chain-of-custody provisions

- Clinical assessment and interviews
- Nursing assessment
- Clinical polygraph examination
- Spiritual assessment
- Timely written report to referral source
- Collection of data from collateral sources, as deemed necessary
- Verbal and written recommendations are given to the board and to the individual being assessed the day after the assessment

WHY PROFESSIONAL ASSESSMENTS?

These assessments are facilitated by a multidisciplinary team involving addiction certified psychiatrists, licensed mental health therapists, and other medical staff. Santé's assessments are tailored to the specific needs of the professional; therefore, the different types of testing can vary from one individual to another.
