Cognitive Processing Therapy (CPT) is an evidenced-based therapy treatment that focuses on examining and challenging maladaptive thoughts and feelings. When individuals experience emotional neglect in some way, often all the way from early childhood and even from the most well-meaning

caregivers, they develop an emotional and behavioral condition that affects their ability to have a healthy, mutually satisfying relationship with not only others, but themselves as well. These individuals become "codependent," in that they maintain relationships that are often one-sided, emotionally destructive and/or abusive.

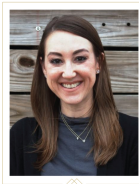

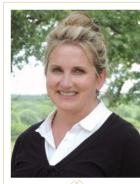
