Faith in the Program

"Simple compliance with the 12-step program is a necessary stage for most AAs to go through, but does

not constitute the full acceptance of the nature of the disease and the ongoing need for support and may, in fact, represent a resistance to full surrender. Surrender, however, refers to the state of complete acceptance of the program, including the surrender of one's will to a Higher Power. This is the spiritual state of acceptance that helps the recovering addict achieve a state of calmness and peace, and which indicates the dropping of resistance to the program and to recovery."


