May You Have Integrity

Step 5 is about transparency, admitting to your Higher Power, others and yourself the details of your wrongs.

Step 5 is Integrity, “the quality of being honest and having strong moral principles; moral uprightness”; one is not able to exhibit this characteristic unless they are clean and sober.

Being able to face inwardly and process all of your wrongs is not an easy feat; you must have a strong support system to lean on, to confide in, and celebrate the cathartic freedom of bringing all of one’s wrongs to light. Allowing yourself to be vulnerable and transparent is part of the process of exhibiting integrity in recovery; working through the 5th Step allows one to truly feel who they truly are for the first time, completing this step is a liberating and powerful accomplishment in one’s recovery journey.

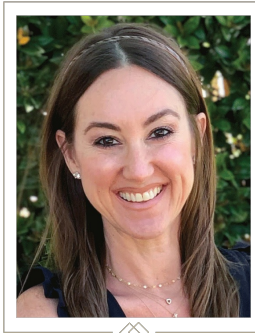

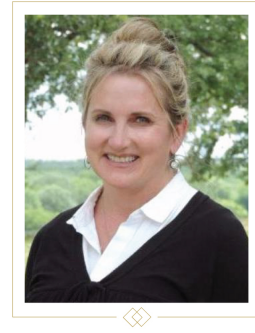
